However, a practical guideline is to keep the total to around 2 liters or 2 kilograms of liquids to optimize space and weight in your luggage. Instead, consider purchasing water after passing through security or bringing a refillable water bottle. This allows you to stay hydrated during travel.

What is the TSA Liquids “3-1-1 Rule?”

” The TSA Liquids 3-1-1 Rule states that you can only bring liquids in containers no larger than 3.4 liquid ounces (100 milliliters) and that all of your liquid containers must fit “comfortably” into one clear, quart-size bag. Where does the 3-1-1 come from?

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) enforces guidelines on liquids in checked luggage and carry-on bags. For carry-on luggage, liquids must be in containers of no more than 3.4 ounces (100 milliliters) each, and there is a limit on the total amount of liquid, including flavored or sparkling water, that can be packed.

Can I bring liquids through airport security checkpoints?

There are several rules that apply when bringing your liquids through airport security checkpoints and, yes, many are obvious to those of us blessed with a shred of common sense. But in some cases there are some less obvious restrictions that could apply to your liquids.

How do I prevent spills or leaks in my checked luggage?

To prevent spills or leakage in your checked luggage, use waterproof bags, pack liquids securely, and choose appropriate containers. Using waterproof bags: Place liquids in sealed plastic or waterproof bags.

Can you drink liquids through airport security?

TSA has several rules you need to follow when it comes to drinking liquids through airport security. The most well-known is the 3-1-1 rule but there are other considerations you need to think about like foods that might trigger the rule and exceptions for medical and baby essentials.
