Overview

Most dangerous goods are forbidden in carry-on and checked baggage. There are a few exceptions for some personal items such as toiletries, medicines, and assistive devices. Check the chart below to see which common dangerous goods are allowed in checked and/or carry-on baggage and which are not.

Yes, most small solar lights can be carried in checked or carry-on luggage, but those with lithium-ion batteries must be in carry-on only if the battery is spare. Generally, solar panels that are separate from the battery packs face no regulations. They can be stored in either checked or carry-on.

Earlier this year, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) announced a ban on several common items that are no longer allowed in checked bags. You can bring lithium-battery powered devices as carry-on items or in checked baggage. Spare lithium batteries are allowed as carry-on items only with batteries individually protected to prevent short circuit. 



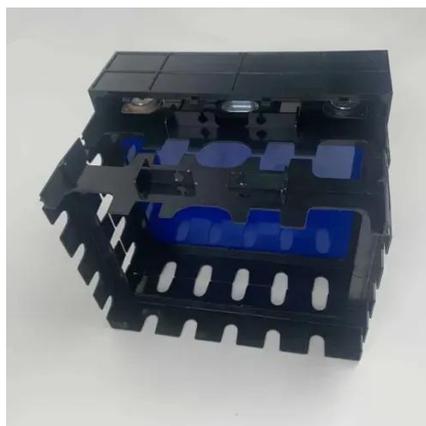
