East Timor has one national public broadcaster, Televisão Timor Leste or Televizaun Timor Lorosae, which broadcasts local programming in Tetum and Portuguese, as well as retransmissions of RTP Internacional from Portugal.

Telkomcel is 100% owned by PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia International (TELIN). There are at least 21 radio stations in East Timor. The main station is Radio Timor Leste, broadcasting in Tetum, Portuguese and Indonesian.

How much bandwidth does East Timor have?

The initial bandwidth was 256 kbit/s. The Internet country code for East Timor is .tl.



This code was officially changed from .tp (for Portuguese Timor) when the country achieved its independence on 20 May 2002.

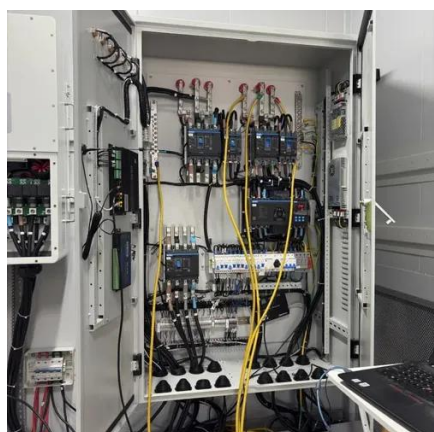

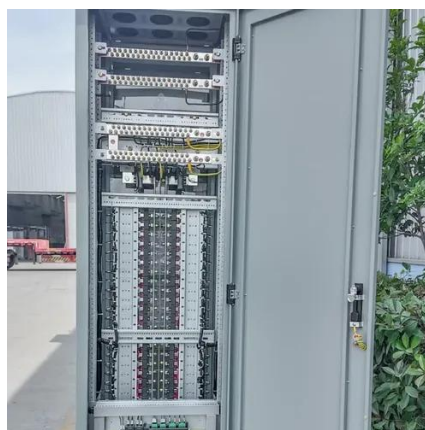
