Last year, African countries ramped up the pace of bringing solar generators into operation: the capacity of solar panels put into operation across the region went from 3.1 gigawatts (GW) in 2022 to 3.7 GW in 2023, according to the Africa Solar Industry Association (AFSIA).

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In 2024, 21 African countries generated at least 5% of their electricity from solar, with 7 countries surpassing the 10% mark. The global solar energy market achieved a historic milestone in 2024, adding an estimated 503 gigawatts (GW) of new capacity, bringing the total installed capacity to over 2.

An inflection point in Africa's adoption of solar energy is now clearly visible, driven by record imports and rapid expansion across dozens of countries on the continent. For years, critics of renewable energy have argued that Africa's economic future depends on extracting and burning more coal.
