The federal solar tax credit (ITC) remains the cornerstone benefit, allowing homeowners to deduct 30% of their solar installation costs from their federal taxes through 2032. Many states complement this with additional incentives like New York's NY-Sun program or New Jersey's Successor Solar Incentive (SuSI).

Do electric utilities offer incentives for solar metering?

While the federal solar tax credit is the only widely available residential solar incentive from the federal government, many states have incentives available to homeowners who adopt solar. Within those states, some electric utilities offer incentives as well. Electric utilities are also responsible for Net Metering.

Which states offer solar rebates & tax credits?

Solar rebates, tax credits, sales tax exemptions and other incentives vary significantly from state to state. Arizona, Hawaii, Massachusetts, New Mexico, New York, South Carolina and Utah offer personal tax credits to encourage solar installations.

What does the federal solar credit include?

What the federal solar credit includes: Keep in mind the federal tax credit only applies to purchased solar systems for first or second homes. Leased solar panels are excluded from the federal tax credit. The 30% credit expires in 2032, after which the credit reduces to 25% in 2033 and 22% in 2034.


