If your power bank is 100Wh or less (roughly up to 27,000mAh), you can carry up to five without any airline approval. If your power bank is between 100Wh and 160Wh, you must get airline approval in advance, and you can carry only two. Power banks over 160Wh are not.

A fire incident aboard an Air Busan aircraft at Gimhae International Airport on Jan 28 was reportedly caused by a power bank. SEOUL – Starting on March 1, passengers boarding flights in South Korea will be required to carry portable batteries and chargers on their person rather than storing them in.

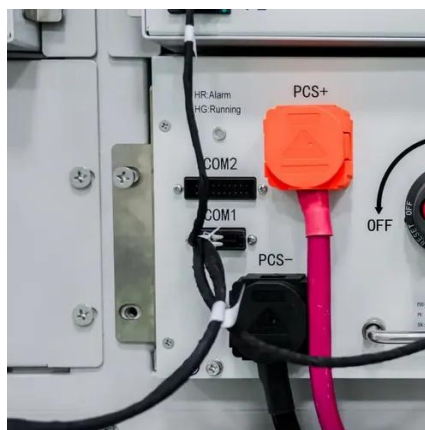

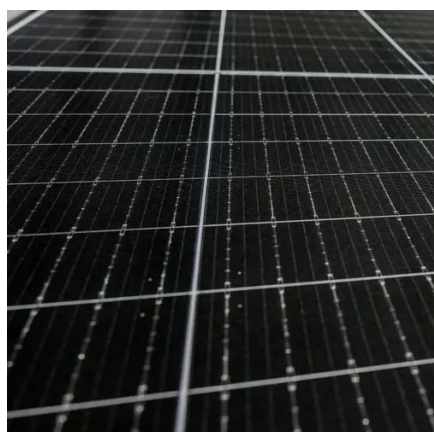
