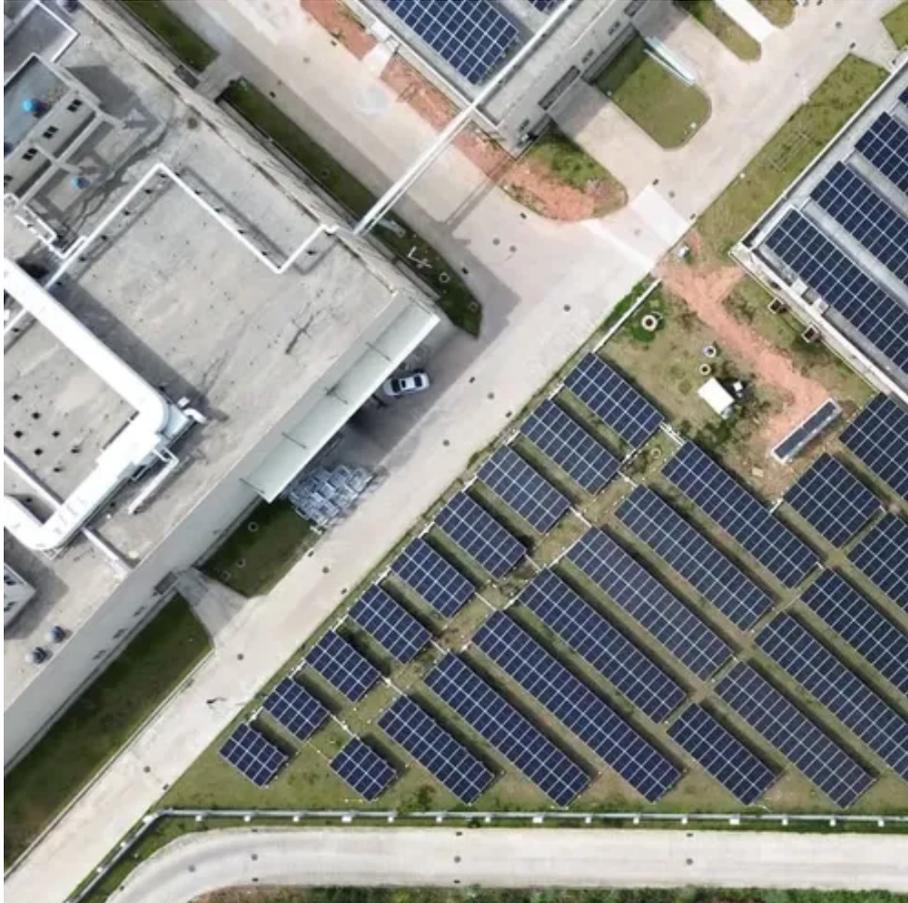

Overview

What is DP World doing at Maputo container terminal?

How will reefer container capacity increase in Maputo?

Reefer container capacity will increase to over 700 plugs, supporting the growth of agricultural exports. Captain Sumeet Bhardwaj, CEO DP World Maputo, said: "The container terminal's increased capacity will lead to faster, cost-effective carrier turnarounds and more competitive freight rates that will attract more vessels to the Port of Maputo."

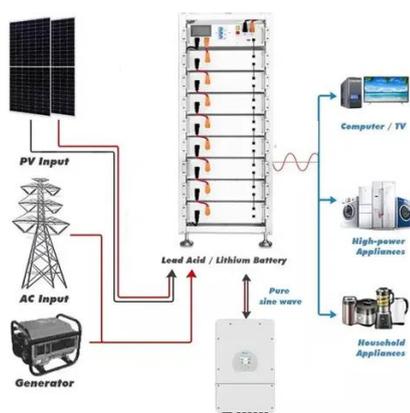




