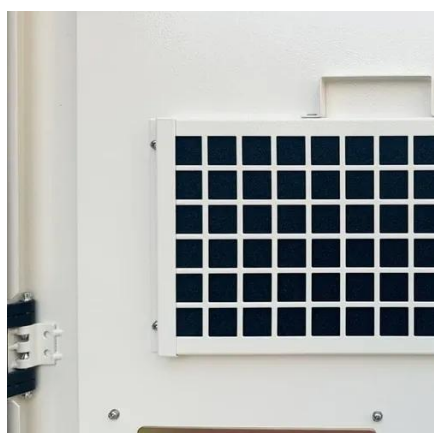

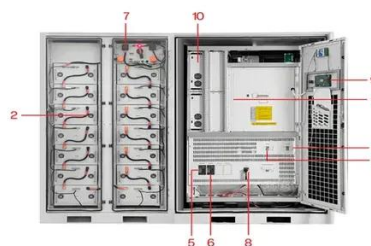


Bylaws of the Organization: Union or Death
