Overview

South Tarawa is a string of on the atoll of , between the Tarawa Lagoon to the north, with a maximum depth of 25 metres (82 ft), and the Pacific Ocean to the south, with a depth of up to 4,000 metres (13,000 ft). The island has been built from sediments from the lagoon. The process of soil accumulation is driven by the dominant easterly trade win.

How did radio communication affect the Battle of Tarawa?

Poor radio communications were a significant factor in the Battle of Tarawa. It contributed to the difficulties faced by the Americans, prolonged the fighting, and increased the death toll. This has been mentioned in various books and documentary videos about the battle.

Where is South Tarawa now?

All of South Tarawa is now urbanised and is effectively one continuous settlement from the northeastern end of the island, Tanaea, to its southwestern end at Betio. Buota in North Tarawa is connected to the South Tarawa main road and is also growing rapidly.

How dangerous is South Tarawa?

The highest point on South Tarawa is only a very few meters above sea level (Eita, 3 metres), making the island extremely vulnerable to natural disasters. The effects of floods and associated soil salination are starting to threaten limited freshwater supplies.





Reaction to Operation Galvanic
Loss of USS Liscome Bay (CVE-65), 24 November 1943
On 24 November 1943, the escort carrier Liscome Bay was operating about 20 nautical miles southwest of Makin Island. Liscome Bay was the flagship of Rear Admiral Henry Mullinnix, commander of Task Group 52.3, a force of three escort carriers. Liscome Bay, Coral Sea (CVE-57, later renamed Anzio), and Corregidor (CVE-58) were tasked with providing air support. See more on history.navy.mil
